Experience and education: Bachelor's degree from an accredited four-year college or university with major coursework in community or regional planning, business or public administration, economics, political science, or a related field. Must have experience in planning, research, project management work, and state and federal grant management. Experience working on transportation planning, community development and policy issues with local or regional governments is desired. Experience and education may be substituted for one another.
