Meeting Minutes

- 1. Call to Order: Sydnee Steelman called the meeting to order at 9:09 a.m.
- 2. Public Comment: No comments were made from the public.
- 3. Staff Update: Air quality readings through the end of June 2019 were shown to the BPAC. Ozone readings for the month of January were 43 parts per billion (ppb) at the Killeen and 41 ppb at the Temple station. Sydnee Steelman announced that the KTMPO newsletter has been posted to social media. Ms. Steelman also asked cities to continuously send any new GIS data to the MPO to maintain updated databases. Lastly, Ms. Steelman updated the group on various regional events occurring within the next few months.
- 4. Action Item: Approval of May 7, 2019 BPAC Meeting Minutes.

Brian Chandler made a motion to approve May 7, 2019 BPAC meeting minutes, seconded by Courtney Peres; the motion passed unanimously.

6. Discussion and Action Item: Bike/Pedestrian Web Application.

Ms. Steelman informed the group that KTMPO staff have been working with the Texas App Team to complete the detail of the regional trail app that is currently being developed. She stated that she would like feedback from the group regarding icons on the home screen, trail highlights, trail classifications, and the point system.

Kendra Coufal stated that the point system could be like the Centex Race Series points system to maintain consistency.

Ms. Steelman stated that BPAC members received a spreadsheet handout to complete with feedback and return. The spreadsheet will be emailed, and feedback is due August 1st.

7. Discussion Item: KTMPO regional trails system.

Ms. Escajeda stated that she would like a complete bike/ped inventory mapped for members to prioritize identified routes. Members then added more routes to the maps provided for them.
