Meeting Minutes

- 1. Call to Order:** Sydnee Steelman called the meeting to order at 9:40 a.m.
- 2. Public Comment:** No comments were made from the public.
- 3. Staff Update:** Sydnee Steelman updated the group about the Complete Streets resolution. She also told the group that crash data for the KTMPPO region is included in the packet to review. Air quality readings through the end of October 2019 were shown to the BPAC. Ozone readings for the month of August were 59 parts per billion (ppb) at the Killeen station and 55 ppb at the Temple station.

Brian Chandler made a motion to approve September 10, 2019 BPAC meeting minutes, seconded by Courtney Peres; the motion passed unanimously.

Katie Deoloz from Rehumanize Mobility gave a presentation to the committee regarding bicycle-pedestrian advocacy.

7. Discussion and Action Item: Fort Hood Installation Management Command.

There was no formal speaker for this item. Mike Love with Fort Hood provided a quick update to the committee regarding current livability projects.

8. Discussion and Action Item: Bike/Pedestrian Web Application.

Ms. Steelman reminded the group to submit more feedback regarding the app to forward to the Texas App Team. The App Team could not attend the meeting to present the finished app to the committee.

9. Discussion Item: KTMPO regional trails system.

Chair Escajeda stated that members could stay after the meeting had adjourned to map bike/ped routes on maps provided by KTMPO staff.

10. Member Comments.


Chair Escajeda stated that the Centex Race Series banquet will be held in December.


11. Discuss Date, Time, and Agenda Items for Next Meeting.
