Meeting Minutes:

- 1. Call to Order: Uryan Nelson called the meeting to order at 9:33 a.m.
- 2. Opportunity for Public Comment: No comments were made by the public.
- **3. Staff Update:** Meeting Schedule; FM 2271 Feasibility Study Public Hearing; Federal and State Updates; Air Quality.

Uryan Nelson informed the TAC of upcoming board and advisory committee meetings through December and shared that staff would continue to work with the Board on what format meetings will take. Mr. Nelson stated that a public hearing for the FM 2271 Feasibility Study is scheduled for November 15th and provided updates to the group on the federal infrastructure grant, DOT's Climate Action Plan, and

FHWA/USDOT's Curbside Inventory Report. Maximum ozone air quality readings for the month of October were 73 parts per billion (ppb) at the Temple station and 77 ppb at the Killeen station.

4. Action Item: Approve minutes from the October 10, 2021 meeting.

Kristina Ramirez made a motion to approve the October 10, 2021 meeting minutes, seconded by Judge Roger Miller; the motion passed unanimously.

5. Discussion and Action Item: Regarding additional Category 7 funds made available through the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA).

Uryan Nelson informed the group that additional Category 7 funds through CRRSAA in the amount of \$2.162 million dollars are available to the MPO. James McGill explained the two funding scenarios that staff is proposing for the additional Category 7 dollars. Several TAC members made comments on the scenarios and were generally in agreement that Scenario D2 was preferred. David Williams requested confirmation that there were no negative impacts with moving the Williams Rd Sidewalk project into the FY21-24 TIP. Staff confirmed that there were not.

David Williams made a motion to recommend approval of Funding Scenario D2: Whole Projects + Williams Rd, seconded by Jason Deckman; the motion passed unanimously.

6. Discussion Item: Regarding Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) Call – FY23-25.

Lauren Wolf with TxDOT Waco District presented on the Waco District's HSIP Program, the recent call for local projects, and future HSIP calls.

7. Discussion Item: Regarding the Bell County Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP).

Judge Roger Miller gave a presentation on the background and development of the HCP along with potential impacts to KTMPO.

8. Public input received through October 2021.

Public input received through October 2021 was presented to the TAC. No new comments were submitted since the last meeting.

9. Member Comments:

10. Adjourn: The meeting adjourned at 10:25 a.m.
