#### **Meeting Minutes:**

- 1. Call to Order: Uryan Nelson called the meeting to order at 9:33 a.m.
- 2. Opportunity for Public Comment: No comments were made by the public.
- 3. Staff Update: Meeting Schedule; Other Updates; Air Quality.

Uryan Nelson informed the TAC of upcoming board and advisory committee meetings through February and stated that the February meetings are planned to be in person with a virtual option at this time. Mr. Nelson shared various transportation related links and reports of note. Mr. Nelson reminded the TAC that

staff are preparing for the Federal Certification Review (FCR) that KTMPO will be undergoing in the spring. Maximum ozone air quality readings for the month of December were 40 parts per billion (ppb) at the Temple station and 55 ppb at the Killeen station.

4. Action Item: Approve minutes from the December 1, 2021 meeting.

Jason Deckman made a motion to approve the December 1, 2021 meeting minutes, seconded by Yvonne Spell; the motion passed unanimously.

**5. Discussion and Action Item:** Regarding recommendation of approval for amendments to the FY21-24 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP).

Uryan Nelson stated that the proposed amendments to the FY21-24 TIP and 2045 MTP had received no comments during the required public hearing and 15-day public comment period.

Darrell Burtner made a motion to recommend approval for amendments to the FY21-24 TIP and 2045 MTP, seconded by Bobby Lewis; the motion passed unanimously.

6. Discussion Item: Regarding ATG presentation on the Bike Share Feasibility Study.

Ben Magallon with Alliance Transportation Group (ATG) presented a brief overview of the Bike Share Feasibility Study they are conducting for KTMPO. TAC members were given the opportunity to provide feedback on the direction of the study.

7. Public input received through December 2021.

Public input received through December 2021 was presented to the TAC. No new comments were submitted since the last meeting.

#### 8. Member Comments:

Jason Deckman shared that the City of Temple will be holding a public meeting on January 19<sup>th</sup> for their Mobility Master Plan development.
